Hans J. Wegner's CH72 sofa is a beautifully crafted fusion of aesthetics, function and comfort, achieved by a series of complex techniques. It features compact proportions and a slimline frame, making the two-seater perfectly suited for a smaller home or a special corner, a pleasure to behold from all angles.

PRODUCTION PROCESS

The frame is bent and welded together. Then it is polished and assembled by hand. The chair consists of molded foam and is then upholstered by hand.

DESIGNER

Danish architect Hans J. Wegner (1914-2007) is considered a pioneering furniture designer of the twentieth century. Often referred to as the master of the chair, Wegner created almost 500 in his lifetime – many of them considered masterpieces. Wegner was part of the spectacular generation that created what is today referred to as 'the Golden Age' of modern Danish design.
